- The candidate must reflect an uncommon act of generosity within the last 12 months that accurately reflects the mission and vision of the Derby Community Foundation, which is "to inspire vision and generosity."
- There is no age limit for a candidate.
- The act of generosity can be in many forms; it does not have to be financial.
- The candidate may also be a civic group, organization, or group of individuals for achievements or contributions to the community.

On a **separate, single sheet of paper**, please tell us why, in your opinion, your candidate deserves this honor. Nominations that exceed one page will not be considered. All nominations should be typewritten. One additional page of biographical information (resume, curriculum vitae, or a list of other projects or organizations the candidate has been involved with) can be attached to the nomination.
